ELIGIBILITY :

For admission to M.Sc. IT, a candidate to be eligible, must have qualified the Bachelor's Degree examination of (10+2+3) pattern in the discipline of Science, Management, Commerce, Arts, Engineering, or Technology or any other degree equivalent of at least three years duration with at least 50% of the aggregate marks (40% for Scheduled Caste/Tribe candidates). Selection for admission to the programme shall be made through an Entrance Test as per the schedule to be notified by the Department of Computer Science & IT.

NO. OF SEATS : 20

The number of seats in M.Sc. IT. shall be determined every year before the commencement of the admission process by the Head of the Department of Computer Science and IT with the prior approval of the Dean Academic Affairs.

Distribution of seats shall be as follows :-

(I) OPEN MERIT CATEGORY :

67% of the total seats belong to open merit category and the remaining 33% of the seats are reserved for the candidates belonging to the following reserved categories, which shall be filled as per the relevant statues governing the general admissions of the University :

- i. Candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes.
- ii. Sportsmen and persons who have excelled in Cultural/Literary Activities.
- iii. Persons who have participated with distinction in N.C.C. & N.S.S. Activities.
- iv. Defence Service Personnel including ex-servicemen and their children who are permanent residents of the state and have had a satisfactory service record.
- v. Candidate belonging to the areas of the Actual Line of Control.
- vi. Candidate belonging to Scheduled Tribes.
- vii. Candidate belonging to Backward Areas other than Leh & Kargil.
- viii. Candidate belonging to S.T. (Resident of Leh & Kargil).
- iv. Candidate belonging to Weak & Underprivileged classes as notified in S.R.O. by the State Govt. from time to time.

However, 50% of the total number of seats shall be reserved for the candidates who are the pass-out of the colleges of erstwhile District Doda and, only, in the event of no such candidate opting for these seats, the same shall be filled up by students from other areas.

The Vice-Chancellor may at his discretion, authorize admission of one orthopedically handicapped candidate, who is suffering from a degree of disability of 45% and above, subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria.

The University offers a limited number of self supported seats in the M.Sc. IT programme which shall be filled as per the relevant statues/regulations governing admissions. These, however, shall be supernumerary seats and thus, shall not be reckoned in determining the quantum of reserved and open merit seats. A candidate seeking admission under the self supported seats shall have to declare his/her intention at the appropriate column in the Application Form and if selected shall have to deposit ₹ 1 lacs at the time of admission in the Department besides the normal fee/charges for the course.

Admission

All the candidates seeking admission to M.Sc. IT course shall be required to appear in an entrance test to be designed and conducted by the Department of Computer Science & IT, University of Jammu or through an agency approved by the Vice-Chancellor. Admission to the course shall be merit based and the selection of the candidates shall be made on the basis of their performance in a written entrance test to be conducted at Jammu at a date and time to be notified by the Department of Computer Science & IT. Inter-se merit of the eligible candidates who have appeared in the Entrance Test shall be determined as follows in their respective categories / groups :

i.) In case of the candidates, belonging to the Open Merit category or those seeking admission under reserved categories, viz. Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Areas, Defence Service Personnel, Actual Line of Control, weak and underprivileged classes or those applying for self-supported seats and discretionary seats, having passed the qualifying examination, the score in the Entrance Test shall be used as the selection criterion to determine the inter-se merit in the respective categories/groups. However, in case of a tie in any of the aforementioned categories/groups, the inter-se merit shall be determined on the basis of a candidate's percentage of aggregate marks in the qualifying examinations.


ii.) In case of the candidates belonging to the other reserved categories, viz. Sportsmen, Cultural and Literary Activities; N.C.C. and N.S.S., selection for admission shall be made on the basis of performance in the Entrance Test plus the achievement score in the respective categories. The composite score for admission purposes shall be determined on the basis of (i) marks/points awarded to such a candidate for these activities as per the relevant University norms plus (ii) one-fourth (1/4) of the percentage of marks secured by the candidate in the Entrance Test. In case the candidates have obtained equal composite score, the tie shall be resolved by reference to their achievement merit in the respective activity. Higher achievement merit shall determine priority in admission.

LAST DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM

Application form complete in all respects should reach the Head, Department of Computer Science & IT, University of Jammu-180006, not later than the dates shown in the advertisement notice. No certificates/ documents will be entertained after the last date of the submission of forms.

ENTRANCE TEST

All applications received in response to the advertisement for M.Sc. IT admission shall be scrutinised and the eligible candidates shall be called to appear in the written Entrance Test. The syllabus of the written test for admission to M.Sc. IT shall consist of Mathematics of 12th standard, Mental Ability & English Comprehension. The syllabus along with a model Question Paper for the examination is given in Annexure-A (Syllabus and Model Question Paper) The test shall be of about two hours duration.



(A) DESCRIPTION OF THE TEST : The candidates will be given a test booklet containing questions. For each question several suggested answers will be given, of which only one answer shall be correct. The questions will have serial numbers 1, 2, 3, etc. and the answer choices for each question shall be marked as A,B,C,D, etc. A separate answer sheet shall be given to answer the questions.

(B) METHOD OF ANSWERING QUESTIONS : On the answer sheet, for each question there shall be a circle (O) under the column heading A,B,C,D. In answering any question, the correct option (i.e. A or B or C or D) of the answer chosen from the question booklet should be noted and the corresponding circle (O) should be blackened with HB pencil against the appropriate question number on the answer sheet. (See sample answer sheet).

(C) IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read the instructions for each of the sections of the test carefully. The test will be divided into several parts.
2. Count the no. of pages on the question booklet before you start. Also check whether the answer sheet is not damaged.
3. Do not give more than one answer to any question as there is only one correct answer to each question. If more than one answer are given for any question, it will be counted as wrong. If after blackening some O on the answer sheet, you want to change your answer, erase the first mark completely and then mark the new one.
4. Follow the instruction given by the supervisor. When supervisor asks you start or stop a test or a section of the test, you must follow his instructions immediately. This is very important.
5. You will not be permitted to take scrap or rough paper, scales or drawing instruments or calculator into the examination hall as they are not needed. Do your rough work in the space provided on the booklet itself.
6. After finishing the test submit the test booklet and the answer sheet to the supervisor. Do not take these out of the hall.
7. Do not forget to write your name, roll number or registration number and the question booklet number on the answer sheet.
8. The candidates are instructed to be careful while answering the questions. The candidates should answer only those questions for which they are fully confident.
9. Anyone found using unfair means in the Entrance Test shall be disqualified and shall lose eligibility for future also.

(d) The candidate's roll number, examination centre & results shall also be available at Jammu University website (www.jammuuniversity.in).

SELECTION NOTIFICATION & APPEAL

- a) Result of the Common Entrance Test shall be notified on the notice board at PG Dept. of Computer Science & IT and the Jammu University website (www.Jammuuniversity.in). The candidates, are advised to keep in touch with the PG Dept. of Computer Science & IT and comply with instructions issued by the department from time to time and displayed on the notice board and university website. Within 3/4 days after the declaration of the Common Entrance Test result, the Dept. of Computer Science & IT shall issue a notification for inviting candidates for admission in order of merit. No complaint shall be entertained in case of non compliance of instructions issued through such admission notices.
- b) Under no circumstances seats lying vacant in any institution on the last prescribed date for the completion of admissions shall be filled up by the HOD / Admission Committee even if the candidate falls immediately next in merit to the last admitted candidate. The vacant seats will be referred to the Appellate Committee for consideration and necessary action.
- c) Notwithstanding anything contained above, a candidate who has any grievance regarding application of statutes governing admissions, shall have the right to file an appeal in the prescribed proforma on payment of fee prescribed for this purpose, as may be notified by the university. Such an appeal shall be considered by the appellate committee. It shall be obligatory for the appealing candidate to appear in person before the appellate committee, if called upon to do so. The appellate form with all the formalities completed is to be submitted to Dean Academic Affairs within the dates notified by the University.
- d) Selected candidates must provide original certificates (of qualifying examination, category, if any, etc.) at the time of admission to M.Sc. IT. Students who have passed the qualifying examination from an institution other than the University of Jammu shall be required to submit the following documents within a period of one month from the date of admission to M.Sc. IT:
 - i) Migration certificate from the university last attended in accordance with relevant statutes.
 - ii) Eligibility certificate issued by the University of Jammu.

Important Instructions for filling in the Application Form

- i) Please fill in the application form carefully and send it by registered post / by hand to the Head, Department of Computer Science & IT, New Campus, University of Jammu, Jammu -180006, so as to reach him not later than the date shown in the advertisement.
- ii) Incomplete / late application will not be entertained.
- iii) Eligible candidates shall be issued Admit Cards by post or by hand on request.
- iv) Eligible candidates will be allowed to appear in the Entrance Test on the production of admit cards. Those who do not receive their admit cards two days prior to the commencement of written test should contact the PG Department of Computer Science & IT in this regard and collect the duplicate admit card personally after submitting attested passport size photograph.
- v) Please attach a certificate of good moral character from the Head of the institution last attended or from a Gazetted Officer. Also attach attested copy of marks certificate of qualifying examination.
- vi) The candidates applying to seek admission under any reserved category must attach with the application form the attested copies of appropriate certificates issued by the competent authority.
- vii) The candidates selected for admission shall have to produce the certificates in original, failing which their admission shall be cancelled.
- viii) Admission / Selection to the M.Sc. IT course shall be provisional, subject to the verification of original certificates and related documents.
- ix) If a selected candidate fails to produce original certificates or deposit the required fee within the specified period of time, his selection shall be cancelled and the seat falling vacant shall be allotted to the next candidate in the merit.
- x) The candidates should remain in touch with the PG Dept. of Computer Science & IT, University of Jammu regarding the declaration of the Common Entrance Test result, merit list and other related informations.
- xi) For determining the number of seats in different reserved categories, fraction of less than half shall be ignored and fraction of a half and more shall be treated as one, subject to the condition that a minimum of one seat is reserved in each of the reserved categories as listed under reserved categories.
- xii) Enclose the list of documents attached with the application form.

IMPORTANT NOTE

In case of any discrepancy / dispute, notwithstanding anything contained in the admission brochure, the statutes / regulations governing admission to M.Sc. IT course in conjunction with general statutes / regulations governing admissions to other Master's Degree programmes of the University shall be followed.



Rules of discipline

1. Students shall be responsible for their conduct and are prohibited from doing anything either inside or outside the department or university campus that will amount to a breach of discipline or interference in the discipline and normal working of the department or university.
2. A student shall be liable to disciplinary action for violation of any of the rules framed by the university authorities time to time. Disciplinary action may involve warning, and / or fine, and / or suspension from classes, from the examination, from use of the Departmental Library or even from the Department as such, or any other action as deemed fit by the concerned authorities.
3. Students shall conduct themselves in a polite manner both towards the staff members, faculty members and towards their fellow students. Insubordination, unbecoming language or ungentlemanly conduct including teasing etc. shall be severely dealt with.
4. Students shall maintain perfect silence in class rooms, laboratories and library and desist from disorderly behaviour. They must not loiter in the corridors or in front of class rooms or office rooms and must keep as quiet as possible at all times. During their free periods students should work quietly in the Library or Reading Room or spend the time without causing any disturbance. Smoking in the campus is prohibited.
5. Students shall take proper care of the University furniture and premises, and they must not spoil or cause any damage to, or tamper with University property, furniture and fittings. They shall not spoil the lawns.
6. Students shall leave their vehicles locked in the area provided for this purpose. No vehicle shall be parked in any other part of the area where traffic blockage or congestion is caused.
7. No Society can be formed in the university without the permission of the authorities nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the university without the prior permission of the authorities.
8. Any kind of arms, even if licensed, shall not be carried in the department or university campus. If any student bears any sort of threat, he shall inform the concerned authority.
