- 2. The candidates are expected to ensure that they meet all eligibility conditions before filling in the application form.
- 3. Please attach a copy of the latest Character Certificate preferably issued by the Head of the Institution last attended or by a Gazetted Officer.
- 4. Please make sure that the candidate has written his/her Name, Address, Telephone number etc. at an appropriate place on the form.
- 5. Details of enclosures must be specified in column 14 of the Admission Form.
- 6. The candidates shall be called in order of merit in class 12th for counselling and allotment of Colleges/Institutions on the basis of merit cum choice and subject to the availability of seats in the concerned College. Counselling schedule shall be notified separately in the Local English Dailies and on the website of the University.
- 7. If a selected candidate fails to produce original certificates or deposit the required fee on the day of Counselling, his/her selection shall be cancelled and the seat falling vacant thus, shall be allotted to the candidate next in order of merit present in the Counselling.
- 8. The candidate having any grievance, may apply on an appeal form obtainable from the University. The appeal form/fee duly complete in all respects should be submitted in the Office of the Director, Colleges Development Council, New Campus, University of Jammu, Jammu within the dates notified by the University for the purpose.

### 1. THE BCA PROGRAMME

BCA course is a three year degree course with annual pattern of examination. The medium of instruction for the Course is English.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

Admission to Part-I class of the BCA course shall be opened to those candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Part-II

examination (under 10+2 pattern) of the J&K State Board of School Education or an examination recognised as equivalent thereto and has obtained <u>atleast 45%</u> of the aggregate marks in the qualifying examination in case of General Category candidates and **40%** marks in case of SC/ST candidates.

### 3. OPEN MERIT SEATS:

There shall be no reservation in Non Government Colleges affiliated with the University of Jammu. Sixty-Seven percent (67%) of the number of seats available in Government Colleges in a course of study shall be filled upon on the basis of open merit.

### 4. **RESERVED CATEGORY SEATS:**

(A) <u>After selection of candidates is made on the basis of open merit in Govt.</u> <u>Colleges, the remaining thirty-three percent (33%) seats, shall be filled up</u> <u>on the basis of reserved categories.</u>

# 5. FEE STRUCTURE FOR COLLEGES AFFILIATED TO THE UNIVERSITY OF JAMMU

### a) <u>NON-GOVT. COLLEGES</u>

The admission fee to be paid at the time of admission through a crossed Bank Draft drawn in favour of Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu and payable at Jammu, shall be Rs.20,960/- p.a. It shall include Corpus Fund, Service Charges and Digitalization fund payable to the University of Jammu by the College.

- i) A refundable library security of Rs.300/- to be deposited in the College.
- ii) In addition to the above, every candidate shall be required to pay other normal fees prescribed by the University viz. Examination fee, Registration Fee, Eligibility Fee (wherever applicable) or any other fee prescribed by the University from time to time.

# Note: Library Security will be charged only once for full course at the time of admission and is refundable to the students after completion of the course.

### b) <u>GOVT. COLLEGES</u>

The admission fee to be paid at the time of admission through a crossed Bank Draft drawn in favour of Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu and payable at Jammu, shall be Rs. 10,405/- p.a.

NOTE:-As the admission fee in the case of Govt. Colleges is Rs.10,405/- per candidate per annum while in the case of Non-Govt. affiliated Colleges the admission fee is Rs.20,960/- per candidate per annum to be deposited with the University through Bank Draft on the spot at the time of admission in the Counselling, the exact amount of fee payable by the candidate depends on the College allotted in the counselling (Govt. or Non-Govt. subject to merit cum

option of the candidate vis-a-vis availability of seats in the College).

In view of the said fact it will be convenient to both the University and the candidates, if the candidates come for the counselling with two bank drafts of Rs.10,405/- & Rs.10,555/- separately to be utilised as per the need.

# 7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND SELECTION

7.1. All admissions (except management seats) to the BCA Course for the session 2011-12 shall be made on the basis of merit-cum-choice through counseling.

- 7.2. No Individual college will admit any student on its own (except management seats).
- 7.3. Names of the candidates to be called for counseling shall be published in the Local English Dailies, Displayed on the Notice Board in the Office of the Director, Colleges Development Council & website of the University of Jammu. No separate intimation shall be given to any candidate. However, the candidates in their own interest, are required to keep in touch with the Office of the Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu and comply with the instructions issued from time to time vide admission Notice(s), failing which the candidate shall be exclusively responsible for any consequential effect emanating therefrom.
- 7.4. All the admissions will be provisional, therefore, the selected candidates shall produce qualification, reserved category and other relevant certificates in original for verification of their eligibility at the time of **Counselling/Admission** and shall deposit the requisite fee in the form of a Bank Draft for Rs.10,405/- or Rs.20,960/- as the case may be on spot failing which their Admission shall stand cancelled and no complaint in this regard shall be entertained.
- 7.5. A candidate admitted to the course shall not take-up any employment or engage himself/herself in any business or attend any other course of instruction or appear in any other examination of any University as long as he/she is on the rolls of the BCA Course.

### 8. <u>SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM</u>

- 8.1 Before filling-in the Application Form and submitting the same to the University, candidates are advised to go through the Brochure carefully to ensure that they fulfill the conditions as laid down for admission to the BCA Course. The amount once paid shall not be refunded/transferred/adjusted under any circumstances.
- 8.2 A candidate desirous of seeking admission to the BCA Course shall submit the prescribed Application Form (appended herewith) duly completed in all respects by Hand/Registered Post/Speed Post/Courier only so as to reach the Asstt. Registrar, (BCA Admissions), Colleges Development Council, Baba Saheb Ambedkar Road, New Campus, University of Jammu, Jammu – 180006 by 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2011 upto 5.00 p.m. without late fee and with late fee of Rs.100/- by 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2011 upto 5.00 p.m.
- 8.3 No candidate shall be allowed to make any change in the Application Form, by way of addition, deletion or alteration once it has been submitted to the University.

8.4 Incomplete Application Form(s) shall not be entertained and no correspondence in this connection shall be made.

# 8.5 **Certificates and other documents to be attached**

Application Form, duly filled in, should be accompanied by photocopies (self attested by the candidate) of the following certificates/ documents:

- (i) Detailed marks certificates of classes 10th & 12th.
- (ii) The candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the schools as regular students are required to submit the character certificate signed by the Principal. Such candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidates should submit the Character Certificates duly signed by a Gazetted Officer.
- (iii) Reserved Category Certificate duly issued by the competent authority. Candidate claiming to be beneficiary of the reservation, for determining eligibility must be a permanent resident of J&K State.
- (iv) One passport size attested photograph pasted at the space provided for the same.

# NOTE:-No certificate or attested copy thereof shall be entertained after the last date for the submission of Application Form.

# 9. APPEALS

- 9.1 In case any candidate feels that the norms governing the admission have not been adhered to, he/she may make an appeal to the Director College Development Council, University of Jammu on the prescribed form (available from the University) after making the requisite payment. The Form duly filled in along with the requisite fee shall be submitted to the, Asstt. Registrar (BCA Admissions), in the Office of the Director Colleges Development Council, New Campus, University of Jammu, Jammu – 180 006 within three days from the last date of admission to BCA course. Such appeals shall be considered by an Appellate Committee comprising the following :
  - (i) Vice-Chancellor (Chairman);
  - (ii) Dean Academic Affairs ;
  - (iii) Dean, Faculty of Mathematical Sciences, University of Jammu;
  - (iv) Head, Department of Computer Science & IT, University of Jammu ;
  - (v) Registrar, University of Jammu;

- (vi) Liaison Officer (legal matters), University of Jammu; and
- (vii) Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu.

### Majority of the members shall form the quorum.

- 9.2 It shall be obligatory on the part of the Appellant to remain in attendance on the scheduled date and time outside the venue of the meeting of the Appellate Committee. He/she will ascertain the date, time and venue of the meeting from the Office of the Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu. He/she shall appear before the Appellate Committee, if called upon to do so. The decision of the Appellate Committee shall be final and binding on the Appellant.
- 9.3. If any difficulty arises in giving effect to these norms or in dealing with a situation not envisaged in the norms, the matter shall be referred to the Vice-Chancellor who shall issue such order as he may deem fit under the circumstances.

### **10. LEGAL DISPUTES**

All legal disputes including therein Consumer Courts relating to the admission of candidates to BCA course shall be subject to Courts having jurisdiction in Jammu only.

Names and locations of the Govt./Non-Govt. Colleges affiliated to University of Jammu for imparting instructions in BCA course for the session 2011-12 shall be displayed in the Office of Colleges Development Council and will also be available on the website of the University of Jammu before the start of Counselling for admission.
