 - 4. Inter-College migratien shall be allowed once in an Academic year.

RULES FOR INTER COLLEGE MIGRATION

- 1 No student who has joined a college affiliated to the Jammu University shall be admitted to another College during the same course unless:
 - a) he has obtained leaving certificate from the Principal of the College from which he intends to migrate. The certificate is not to be given by the Principal until the transfer has been notified by the University.
 - b) the Principals of both the Colleges agree and the fee of Rs. 1101 has been paid to the University.
- 2 A student who is detained or conditionally promoted, shall not be admitted to a highe class by the Principal of the other college, on migration.
- 3 Tuition Fee, if any, shall be payable by the student to the Principal of the College from which he migrates up to and including the month in which he obtains leaving certificate. Tuition fee for the same month shall not be charged by the College to which he migrates.
