In the event of non receipt of any objection(s) from any of the candidates, it shall be presumed that the candidates have no objection to the scores allotted to them and the final list of the candidates to be invited for the interview shall be drawn accordingly.

Kindly note that only first twenty eligible shortlisted applicants will be called for interview against one advertised post and for every additional post, five more applicants will be considered while short-listing for the interview purpose and so on. Shortlisted candidates will be required to appear before the duly constituted Selection Committee and the selection will be made as per the prescribed selection criteria given below :-

Selection Committee Criteria/ Weightage (Total Marks = 100)

- Academic Record and Research Performance (50%)
- Assessment of Domain Knowledge and Teaching Skills (30%)
- Interview performance (20%).
