The Convener Board of Studies in Education welcomed the members both off line and on line, presented the achievements of the Department of Education in the last one year through PPT and then read out the agenda items to be discussed in the meeting followed by decisions taken which are:-



1. To confirm the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Studies in Education held on 25-09-2020

The minutes of the meeting of BOS in Education held on 25-09-2020 were confirmed.

2. To revise the syllabus and courses of studies in the subject of Education of Master Degree Programme for Semesters I to IV under the Curriculum Reforms of RUSA 2.0 under the Choice Based Credit System for the examinations to be held in the years mentioned below:

M A Education

Semester-I December 2021, 2022 and 2023

Semester II May 2022, 2023 and 2024

Semester III December 2022, 2023 and 2024

Semester IV May 2023, 2024 and 2025

The members unanimously approved the syllabus of M.A. Education for all Semesters I, II, III & IV under the curricular reforms of RUSA 2.0 under the Choice Based Credit System for examinations to be held as mentioned above.

The existing syllabus for M.A. Education be allowed to continue for reappear candidates only for one academic session under CBCS.

3. To review the syllabus and courses of studies in the subject of Education for Semesters I, II, III & IV under the Choice Based Credit System at the Undergraduate level for the examinations to be held in the years mentioned below:

Semester-I December 2021, 2022 and 2023

Semester II May 2022, 2023 and 2024

Semester III December 2021, 2023 and 2023

Semester IV May 2022, 2023 and 2024

Semester V December 2021, 2022 and 2023

Semester VI May 2022, 2023 and 2024

It was unanimously decided by the members that skill courses should be prepared with a focus on experiential learning and its foundation should be NEP 2020. Proficiency based courses like Adult education, Non-formal education, First-Aid, Water Conservation, Waste management, Health Concerns, Forest management, Red-cross activities, Plantation, Yoga Education and Bharat Scouts and Guides should be included.

Courses like- Theatre in Education, Art and Craft in Education, Cultural Preservation and Children with Special Needs & Counseling should be included (which should be practical-based) in the syllabus.

Following members were requested to prepare the syllabus of following courses and submit the same in two weeks for the next academic session:

- i. Art & Craft in Education: Dr Rakesh Bharti
- ii. Cultural Preservation: Dr Ashok Kumar
- iii. Children with Special Needs & Counseling: Dr Ram Singh Sambyal

iv. ICT Practical: Ms Pooja Devi

The existing Syllabus of **Semester I, II, III, IV, V & VI** of all courses (core courses, skill courses & generic courses) will continue for the academic session- 2021.

4. **To formulate the syllabus and courses of studies in the subject of Physical Education for the semester V and VI under the Choice Based Credit System, at the Undergraduate level for the examinations to be held in these years:**

B.A. (Physical Education)

Semester-V December 2021, 2022 and 2023

Semester-VI May 2022, 2023 AND 2024

The members unanimously recommended the following changes:

- i. Unit titles should be added in all the courses.
- ii. In Course UPETC501 profiles of eminent sports persons should be added in Unit-II & Unit-III Motivation and Personality and titles should be contextualized with respect to Sports Psychology.
- iii. Numbering of sub-units and grammatical errors should be rectified throughout the syllabus.
- iv. Balance the syllabus with respect to number of units throughout the course as it has been observed by the members that there are 05 units and in some there are 04 units in the courses of different semesters.
- v. Course on Emotional development can be added.

The members unanimously **approved the syllabus of Physical Education at Undergraduate level Semester V & VI** under the Choice Based Credit System for examinations to be held as mentioned above.

5. **To indicate the percentage of change in the syllabus and courses of study mentioned in the item 2 & 3 on each paper/course no.**

The percentage of change in the syllabus and courses of study mentioned above in the item 2 & 3 on each paper/course no. is less than 20 %.

6. **To prepare a panel of paper setters/examiners to be sent to the Controller of Examinations, University of Jammu, Jammu.**

BOS authorized the Convener to prepare the panels for different examinations.


7. **Any other matter :**

- i. The Convener asked the members to request their college Principals to provide **data with regard to Education Faculty position** in their respective colleges so that the names of all the Faculty members could be included in different panels based on their length of service and subject specializations.

- ii. Members present **shared their experiences** about the new syllabus being taught by them and practical difficulties faced at grass root level.
- iii. Members have been requested to send their e-content for uploading in the **NCTE OER portal**.
- iv. It was also suggested that **Special Education Course** should have some realistic content like including case studies.
- v. The need to follow constructivist and creative teaching styles was discussed to transact the curriculum at grass root level in order to make learning an enjoyable journey for the students. It was also suggested that courses at Under Graduate level based on market and societal needs should be included.

Convener desired that the members of BOS should be in constant touch with the Department and should participate in all academic activities from time to time.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
