“NSS Campus Units JU organized National Unity Day-Rastriya Ekta Diwas-2022 and Cleanliness Drive”

To celebrate the Rashtriya Ekta Diwas- the Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel-India's First Home Minister and Freedom Fighter, referred to as the Iron Man of India for bringing together thousands of Princely states to form the National Union that we call India, the National Service Scheme(NSS) Campus Units, University of Jammu, organized a series of events to celebrate as "National Unity Day-Rastriya Ekta Diwas-2022", under the aegis of "Azadi Ka Amrit Kaal" on 31st October 2022.
