Skill Courses offered by the University Entrepreneurship and Skill <u>Development Centre</u>

1. One Month Training Course on Mushroom Cultivation:-

Mushroom Cultivation Course was organised in collaboration with department of Botany, University of Jammu, Jammu from 31st Jan'2020 to 26th Feb'2020. The program was inaugurated by Prof. Manoj K. Dhar Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Jammu. The Program was co-ordinated by Dr. Sikander Pal.

<u>Major activities undertaken:</u> The program was aimed at imparting mushroom cultivation practices along with entrepreneurial skill to the youth of UT of J&K. First batch of the Program successfully trained 20 students belonging to different parts of the UT of J&K. Participants besides learning the mushroom cultivation also sharpened their entrepreneurial acumen. After the successful completion of training, about five participants have shown leads in developing MSME projects in collaboration with UESDC, University of Jammu.

2. 15 Days Course on Life Skills:-

A 15 day Life Skills Course was organised in collaboration with Department of Lifelong Learning, University of Jammu for the students of Government Degree College, Reasi through online mode from 4th January 2021 to 22nd January 2021. The program was inaugurated by Prof. Manoj K. Dhar Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Jammu and Sh. Talat Parvez Rohilla, Commissioner Secretary, Higher Education. The Valedictory of the program was held on 22nd January 2021 wherein Prof. Naresh Padha was the Chief Guest. The Principal of the college along with other faculty attended the program besides the Convener, UESDC and Director, DLL. The participants of the program in their feedback appreciated the contents of the program and highlighted the need for such program. This unique course prepared the participants to contribute towards the welfare of this special group of individual through their early identification and remedial intervention. Best of the resource persons ranging from psychotherapist, psychiatrist, educationists, researchers and special educators contributed towards designing and execution of the course. The program was co-ordinated by Dr. Sarika Manhas.

The Course was designed with the objective that after its successful completion the trainees will be able to:

- Describe and Differentiate among different types of Specific Learning Disability.
- Describe various approaches and techniques of Screening.
- Apply selected informal and formal screening tools for initial screening of students with learning differences.
- Understand the concept of neuroplasticity and emotional impact of LD.

5. One Week Course on Bamboo, Cane and Straw Crafts development and its Conservation:-

Skill Development Training Program on Bamboo, Cane and Straw Crafts Development and its Conservation was organised in collaboration with Centre for Studies in Museology, University of Jammu and supported by Tripura Bamboo Mission, Governemnt of Tripura from 22nd March 2021 to 27th March 2021. The theme of the Workshop was chosen to align with the University's mandate of skill development and entrepreneurship and by how innovation can help the society to make a transition from "Job Seeker to Job Provider". The program was graced by the presence of Prof. Manoj K. Dhar, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, University of Jammu. 6. "5 Days Workshop on Mountaineering":-

A Weeklong workshop on Mountaineering was organised by the Directorate of Sports and Physical Education, University of Jammu in collaboration with Pir Panjal Adventures, Jammu under the agies of University Entrepreneurship and Skill development Centre on the occasion of "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" w.e.f 25th March 2021 to 31st March 2021. The workshop was a combination of training lectures on different topics including hiking, climbing, CPR, Rappelling, river crossing, food hunting skills, tent pitching and other mountaineering skills s well as a two days field training on above mentioned topics. The workshop was attended by more than 150 students, staff members of the different wings of JU and Bhaderwah Campus. The Program was co-ordinated by Dr. Daud Iqbal Baba.

7. Signed MoU with JKEDI:
