

Rules for the Use of Property Counter of the Dhanvantri Library

- 1.** The use of the property counter ("Counter") is available to registered patrons of the library ("Patrons") only. The Library reserves the right to deny the use of the Counter to any Patron at any time, for any reason, and without prior notice.
- 2.** The Counter is to be used solely for the temporary storage of personal property brought into the Library. The Library shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or theft of any personal property stored at the Counter.
- 3.** Patrons shall be responsible for their personal property at all times and shall not leave any property unattended on the Counter or elsewhere within the Library. The Library shall not be liable for any loss, damage, or theft of any personal property left unattended, or for any personal injury resulting there from.
- 4.** Patrons are prohibited from storing any hazardous or dangerous materials in or around the Counter. Patrons who violate this rule may be subject to expulsion from the Library and/or legal action.
- 5.** Patrons shall comply with any instructions provided by Library staff regarding the use of the Counter. Failure to comply with such instructions may result in denial of access to the Counter or expulsion from the Library.
- 6.** The Library reserves the right to inspect any personal property stored at the Counter for the purpose of ensuring compliance with these rules. Patrons who refuse to allow such inspection may be denied access to the Counter and/or expelled from the Library.
- 7.** Patrons shall remove all personal property from the Counter prior to leaving the Library. Any property left unclaimed for a period of 30 days may be disposed of by the Library in its sole discretion.
- 8.** These rules may be amended by the Library from time to time, in its sole discretion, without prior notice to Patrons. Such amendments shall be effective immediately upon posting in the Library and shall be binding on all Patrons who use the Counter thereafter.
