The online essay writing competition is open to all Students under the age of 25 years as on 15.08.2022, who are currently enrolled in a course of study at any institution recognized by any university in India.

Topics for the online essay competition for the year 2022 are as follows:

- The CAG: Helping India achieve Panchamrit - five nectar elements to deal with climate change
- The CAG: Realising the Constitution's vision, Enlivening Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav
- CAG@2047: Imagine you are the CAG of India in year 2047. What will be your strategy for the Institution?

Participants can submit an essay on any one of the above topics. The essays will be evaluated separately in English and Hindi. Winners of the competition will be awarded cash prizes as follows:

First prize:	30,000
Second prize:	20,000
Third prize:	15,000

Participants may write an essay on any one of the topic in either English or Hindi, up to maximum limit of 1500 words. Essays are to be submitted by the participants via email at essay2022@cag.gov.in by 1700 hrs on 15th September 2022.
