Degree College, Doda wherein the students were allotted Major and Minor Courses in the same subject in Semester-1st and Semester-3rd:

Minor Course allotted in Semester-3 rd in the <u>Accounting</u> and <u>Finance</u>	Minor Course to be alloted in Semester-3 rd in the <u>Business</u> <u>Regulations</u>
Financial Accounting (Basic) UMIBCT301	Insurance Law UMIBCT331

The credits of Minor Courses mentioned above already earned by the students shall be incorporated in their Marks Card as additional course/credits. The students shall not claim for the merit certificate on the basis of these credits.

The college shall submit the marks of Internal Assessment, Practical/Tutorial if any, to the University for the Courses which have been changed. The students shall fill the examination form and appear as reappear candidates in the next examination of 1st and 3rd whenever held.

The main markscard shall display only the Major and Minor Courses and other papers as per the Statutes. The marks card for the additional credits earned should be issued separately from the main marks card in order to avoid any confusion or future precedence and also the Original old marks card of previous examination of 1st and 3rd shall be cancelled to avoid duplicacy.

The above relaxation shall be given in respect of the Statute 22(ii) of the Statutes Governing Four Year Under Graduate Programme (NEP-2020), as one time exception and not to form precedence.
