1.	The HOD concerned shall recommended up-to 05 applications of the students after conducting initial screening through the DAC in order of merit. 2.	The cap of Students Aid Fund shall be ₹ 15,000/- per student.	The cap of Students Aid Fund shall be ₹ 18,000/- per student.										
3.	The Family income slab should not be more than ₹ 20,000/-	The family income slab should not be more than ₹ 25,000/- per month.										
4.	Addition/Not existing	Any special circumstances as deemed appropriate by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, student can be considered for grant of assistance in relaxation of the guidelines and eligibility conditions of Students Aid Fund which shall be subject to the following conditions: a. Any unfortunate mishap, death or permanent disability of the sole provider of the student's family resulting in serve financial hardship. b. The student have not claimed financial assistance from any other source.										
5.	Addition/Not existing	A student shall be eligible to avail financial assistance under the Students Aid Fund only once during the entire duration of the course, provided that the student is not availing or receiving any scholarship, financial assistance, stipend or other monetary benefit from any other source for the same purpose.
