Baber Irshad was top scorer with 48 runs off 52 balls studded by a boundary and a six. H Uppal also played well and made 22 off 18 balls with the help of two boundaries. Iftiaz (16 off 12 balls, 2×6) and Abhishek (14 off 14 balls, 2×4) were the other main scorers.

For GDC Kathua, Ram Parsad was the most successful bowler, who claimed three wickets in his four overs spell followed by Sahil, who took two wickets. Kush and Abhay claimed one wicket each.
