#### **Activity 1**

#### **Induction programme from 4<sup>th</sup> August 2026 and 6<sup>th</sup> August 2026**

The Department organized an Introductory Session for the students admitted under two (2) year programme of Semester 1<sup>st</sup> (2026 – 2028 session) and one (01) year programme of Semester 1<sup>st</sup> (2026 – 2027) with the objective to familiarize them with the academic environment, faculty members, and departmental facilities. 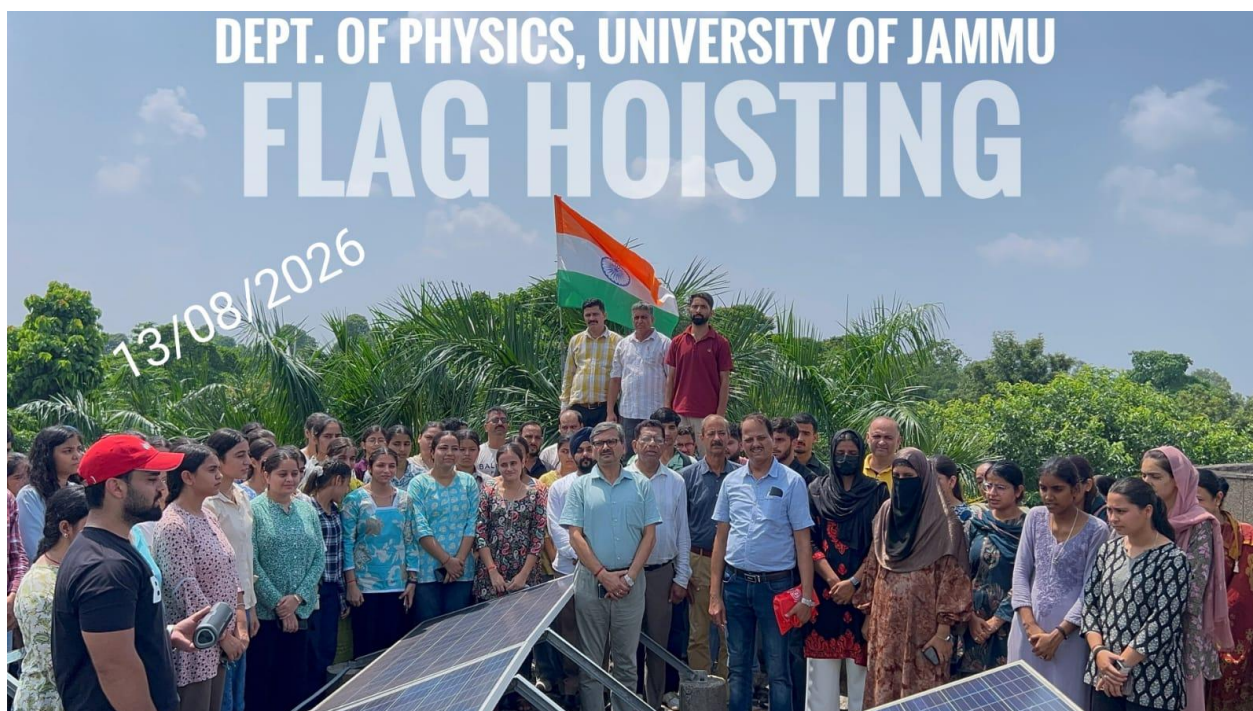




## **Activity 2**
