**PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF OFF-LINE APPLICATION FORM:**

Offline applications are invited from eligible candidates on the prescribed form for the admission to the *Two-Year Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.)* in the Non-Government College (Trikuta College of Physical Education, Nardani, Raipur, Jammu), affiliated to **University of Jammu** for the session 2026-28.

<b>MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY</b>	<p>A candidate who has passed the following examination shall be eligible for the B.P.Ed programme.</p> <p>(i) Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% of aggregate Marks for General category 45% SC/ST Category and having at least participation in the Inter-College/Inter-Zonal/ District/ School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>(ii) Bachelor's degree in Physical Education</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>(iii) Bachelor's degree in any discipline and studied physical education as compulsory/ elective subject.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>(iv) Bachelor's degree and having participated in National/Inter University / State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter College / Inter-Zonal/ District/ School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>(v) Bachelor's Degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/ AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>(vi) Graduation Degree and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in service candidates i.e., trained physical education teachers / coaches). The persons with disabilities are not eligible for admission to the programme. The candidates qualifying the written exam test shall have to further appear in the Physical Fitness Test to be conducted by the Department of the Physical Education, University of Jammu. The number of candidates to be invited for appearing in the Canadian Test shall not exceed three (3) times the number of seats available in the Directorate. The selection for admission shall be made on the basis of composite merit obtained in the Entrance Test out of those qualifying the Canadian Test.</p>

**A. IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR COUNSELLING/ ADMISSION:**

1. In case the last semester result is still to be declared, the candidate must submit an affidavit citing that he/she shall produce the result card within 25 days after the start of classwork. Such students shall only be provisionally admitted & their candidature stands cancelled if the marksheet is not submitted within the stipulated time.
2. In case of non-compliance with the requirements for admission, including non-submission of relevant document's and/or non-payment of Fee/s within the stipulated date and time, the candidate will lose his/her right to admission. If at any stage, documents submitted by the candidate relating to the admission are found to be fake/not-genuine and /or else fabricated information or in any other manner defective, the said candidate will not be given admission and if already admitted, admission will be cancelled without any prior notice in this regard. If any discrepancy is found after completing the Program, his/her degree will be revoked appropriate legal action will be taken against him/her. The University of Jammu reserves the right to cancel the admission of any candidate who violates the rules and regulations laid down and by the University.



3. University of Jammu will not be responsible for a candidate's lack of awareness of the admission guidelines, schedule, eligibility criteria, and rules defined in this document. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to keep checking at the respective College.
4. If a candidate has applied for admission but doesn't fulfil the eligibility criteria of any program offered by concerned College, his/her candidature will not be considered.
5. If all the documents are found to be in order and the eligibility criteria are met by the candidate, the College will provisionally approve the Allocated Seat. In that case, the candidate will have to take the admission on the approved allocated seat by paying the admission fee in the concerned college within the stipulated time.
6. The candidate must adhere to the stipulated timelines for all allocation and admission rounds.

**B. Document Verification by the Admission Committee of the Concerned Private College.**

1. Offline Application Form alongwith Document verification will be done for candidates before the allocation round by the respective College Admission Committee. Candidates with **no document deficiencies** will receive allocation approval from the respective College Admission Committee.
2. After verification, the college will either "**Approve or Reject**" application form of the candidate. The Merit List of Admitted candidates will be notified by the respective College on their official website and Notice Board of the College with the intimation to the office of College Development Council duly signed by the Admission Committee of the College and the Principal.
3. After allocation of preferred seats, students shall have to visit the allotted College with all the original documents along with one set of photocopies of self-attested documents for physical document verification with the scheduled time slot and date allotted in the Admission Schedule (Annexure-II).

**C. APPEALS**

In case a candidate, who has filled his/her Offline Application Form and deposited the requisite application fee has any grievance and feels that the norms governing the admission have not been adhered to by the concerned Private College, he/she shall have the option to make an appeal on the prescribed form on payment of fee as prescribed by the University in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of the **Director College Development Council payable at Jammu**. The form duly filled in shall be submitted in the **Office of Director (CDC) within seven days after the last prescribed date of admission**.

**D. IMPORTANT NOTES: -**

1. College shall have an approved **Admission Committee** to be notified alongwith contact details for scrutiny and verification of documents of candidates. The committee shall consist of:
  - **Principal of the College**
  - **Two senior faculty members of the college concerned.**It must be notified by the College on its website.



2. The Admission Committee of college concerned shall be wholly solely responsible for admission of the students in their respective College. In case, if any, wrong admission or admission to ineligible candidate(s), the Principal/Incharge of the Admission Committee shall be liable to face the legal consequences arising thereof, if any, and the University may also impose a penalty as per the decision of then Competent Authority on the College for each wrong admission and the College will be responsible to pay the same to the University as and when demanded.
3. As per University Council Resolution No. **75.15 dated 11.10.2013**, if the number of students admitted in a non-government affiliated college in a course is less than 20 or less than 50% of the sanctioned intake of that college (whichever is less), the said course shall not be allowed to be run in that college.
