Baisakhi Celebration

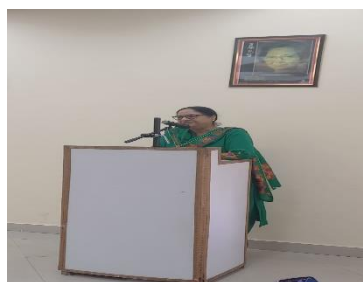
