ABOUT THE HOST CENTRE

The Centre for Study of Social Exclusion and Inclusive Policy was established in the year 2008 in the University of Jammu with a purpose to support research in the area of social exclusion, which has theoretical as well as policy importance. The focus of such research is on social exclusion related to dalits, tribal or religious minorities, women, physically challenged etc. The key objectives of the centre are:

Conceptualising discrimination, exclusion & inclusion based on caste/ethnicity & religion; developing understanding of the nature & dynamics of discrimination & exclusion, understanding of discrimination at the empirical level and formulating policies for protecting the rights of these groups & eradicating the problem of exclusion & discrimination. The Centre acts as nodal agency to conduct/ organize such activities.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

The city hosts the famous Raghunath Temple, Bagh-e-Bahu, Bahu Fort etc., within the municipal limits. The famous Vaishno Devi shrine is about 55 km from Jammu.

ABOUT THE SEMINAR

- vii. Support for Traditional, Agricultural & Livelihood System.
- viii. Education & Tribals/Dalits-Mobile Schools & Open learning
- ix. Economic Empowerment of Tribal Caste groups.
- x. Sustainable Development Programmes & Poverty Reduction among Tribal & Dalit groups in North West region.
- xi. Government policies for marginal communities and role of inclusive policies and any other topic associated with the theme.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Abstracts not exceeding 500 words are invited on the sub-themes. The abstract be typed in English Times New Roman with font size 12, line spacing 1.5 and in Hindi krutidev 10 in pdf form. The abstract should include title, name(s) of the author/co-author and organization, their address including e-mail. The name of the presenting author should be in bold. The abstract should be submitted electronically in 'MS Word file to the e-mail id: socialexclusionju@gmail.com on or before 25-02-2024.
