This National Seminar aims to examine these developments within the Indian and global employment landscape by focusing on structural shifts, emergent skill logics, and institutional and policy responses. The seminar seeks to provide a forum for academicians, researchers, policy practitioners, and students to deliberate on the challenges and opportunities in the evolving employment ecosystem.

CONFERENCE FORMAT

The two-day seminar will be organized in physical mode at the Department of Lifelong Learning, University of Jammu. The programme will include inaugural and plenary sessions featuring eminent speakers, followed by technical paper presentations across multiple thematic tracks. The event will conclude with a valedictory session summarizing key discussions.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

Abstract Submission: Prospective participants are invited to submit an abstract of 250—300 words, accompanied by five to six keywords, in a Microsoft Word document. The abstract should succinctly summarize the proposed paper's objectives, methodology, and key arguments, and must clearly indicate its alignment with the conference theme and sub-themes.

Each submission should include the author's name, designation, institutional affiliation, and contact details. Abstracts must be submitted via email to directordllconference 2025 agmail.com not later than 5th January 2026.

Submissions are expected to demonstrate **original scholarly insight-by** advancing new knowledge, fostering interdisciplinary dialogue, critically analysing existing policy or institutional frameworks, or proposing innovative perspectives and reform-oriented approaches to employment, skill development, and labour market transformations.

Communication of Abstract Acceptance: The Organizing Committee will notify all applicants regarding the status of their abstract submission by 15th January 2026. The Committee's decision on the acceptance and inclusion of papers for presentation in the seminar shall be final and binding.

Full Paper Submission: Authors whose abstracts are accepted are required to submit their full-length papers by 25th January 2026.

Paper Formatting Guidelines:

Length: 4,000—6,000 words (including references).

Structure: The paper should be well-organized with appropriate headings and subheadings.

Citation Style: APA 7th Edition format is recommended.

Document Specifications: Manuscripts must be prepared in Microsoft Word, on A4-size paper, with 1-inch margins on all sides, using Times New Roman, 12-point font, and 1.5 line spacing.

ETHICAL STANDARD

All research papers submitted must be the original and unpublished work of the author(s). The Organizing Committee upholds a strict anti-plagiarism policy, which forbids any uncredited use of others' ideas, text, data, or research findings. Submissions that do not comply with the required standards of academic integrity will be excluded from consideration.

All registered participants are required to attend both days of the conference to qualify for certification. Certificates will be issued at the conclusion of the event, either in physical or electronic format.

PUBLICATION OPPORTUNITIES

All accepted abstracts will be published in the seminar proceedings. Selected high-quality papers will be considered for publication in an edited book with ISBN and in peer-reviewed journals, subject to editorial review.
