ORDER

Sanction is hereby accorded in anticipation to the approval of the University Syndicate, for adoption of the following guidelines decided by the Academic Council after thorough deliberations of the Committee constituted by the University w.r.t empanelment of need-based Teaching Faculty in the University of Jammu from Academic Session 2026-27 onwards:-

1. The concerned Rector/Director/HOD is authorized to empanel eligible candidates as Assistant Professors on purely temporary and need basis as per the requirements of respective Campus/Directorate/Department/Centre/ Constituent College as per the screening criteria of UGC Regulations 2018 (**Annexure-I**).
2. The basic eligibility criteria shall be as per UGC Regulations 2018.
3. The empanelment shall be of maximum upto 10 candidates in each course/subject.
4. The Criteria for engagement of particular candidate out of the empanelled candidates shall be as per the requirements vis-à-vis expertise of the candidate.
5. The engagement from the empanelled candidates shall be accomplished by respective Rectors/Directors/HODs/Principals in consultation with the Campus Affairs Committee (CAC)/ Departmental Affairs Committee (DAC) through a process of interview only based on the performance.
6. The engagement shall be purely on a need basis for a semester during an Academic Session, depending upon the requirements of the respective courses. The re-engagement of already engaged faculty for another semester shall be subject to requirement, satisfactory performance and feedback received from students, Course Co-ordinator/Rector/Director/ HOD/Principal, as the case may be, with the approval of Dean Academic Affairs.
7. The engaged staff shall be required to furnish an undertaking, duly sworn-in before the 1st Class Magistrate stating that they shall not claim any permanent absorption against said arrangement, which is purely temporary and need based.
8. A consolidated monthly salary shall be paid to the engaged faculty as per the prevailing norms of the University, as revised from time to time.

Further a Committee shall be constituted by Registrar for finalization of operational guidelines/SOPs and for clarification of other common issues in the matter.

Eligibility Criteria

A.

- I. Good Academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- II. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and master's level for the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/ Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in appoint scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories motioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace marks procedures.
- III. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- IV. The National Eligibility Test (NET) or an accredited test (State Level Eligibility Test SLET/SET) shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor and equivalent positions wherever provided in these Regulations. Further, SLET/SET shall be valid as the minimum eligibility for direct recruitment to Universities/Colleges/Institutions in the respective state only:
- V. Provided that candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2009, or the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degree) Regulation, 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or any equivalent position in any University, College or Institution.
- VI. Provided further that the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree. All such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only;
 - b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
 - c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
 - d) The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a referred journal;
 - e) The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean Academic Affairs of the University concerned.

The clearing of NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for candidates in such disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET has not been conducted.

OR

- B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

For Remote Sensing & GIS

- i. Master's Degree in Remote Sensing & GIS with NET/SET in the relevant subject with not less than 55% of marks

Or

Master's Degree in Geology/Geography/Botany/Agriculture/Environmental Sciences with PG Diploma in Remote Sensing & GIS and NET/SET in the Relevant Subject with not less than 55% marks. In case of candidates having Master's Degree in Geology/Geography/Botany/Agriculture/ Environmental Sciences, preference shall be given to candidates having substantive research and publications in Remote Sensing & GIS at the PhD. Level.

- ii. Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009/2016, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions.

For IME at Bhaderwah Campus:

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in **Environmental Sciences/Botany/Zoology** from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- ii. NET/SET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided, however, that the candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. Degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions.

For Yoga:

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. NET/SET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

Provided, however, that candidates, who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009/2016, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SET/SLET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions.

Further, the award of degrees to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July11, 2009, shall be governed by the provision of the then existing ordinances/By Laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degrees and the Ph.D. Candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility conditions of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in University/Colleges/Institutions subject to submission of MSP certificate issued by the competent authorities of the concerned University.

For BBA-HM in SHTM:

- i. Bachelor's Degree in Hospitality Management/ Hotel Management / Hospitality Administration / Culinary Arts/ Culinary Science with minimum of 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade from a recognized University.
- ii. A Master's degree with 55% marks in Hospitality and Tourism Management (HT)/ Hospitality Management/ Hotel Management/ Hospitality Administration from a recognized University/ Institute.
- iii. Ph.D degree in the relevant subject (Hospitality) from a recognized University with reputed publication in UGC-Care/ Scopus indexed/ National and International Journals.

For MBA-TTM in SHTM:

- 1) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Tourism Management/ Tour and Travel Management from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.

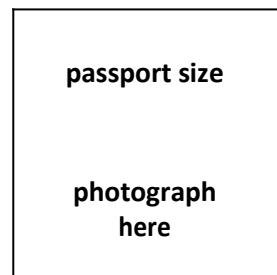
