Jammu University Entrance Test (JUET) 2022, Academic Session 2022-23.

Applications are hereby invited for the admission to the various Academic Programmes of the University of Jammu i.e. the Main Campus/ Offsite Campuses and Affiliated Colleges for the Academic Session 2022-23. The Admission shall be made on the basis of the Composite Merit comprising the Academic Score of the qualifying examination (75%) and the Jammu University Entrance Test (JUET) Score (25%).

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Appearance of a Candidate in JUET is mandatory for seeking Admission to all such Courses/ Programmes of the University of Jammu which come in the ambit of JUET. Non-appearance in JUET will render a Candidate ineligible for Admission.
2. **The JUET-2022 shall be held for seeking Admission to the following Courses/ Programmes:**
 - a) **Post Graduate (PG) Programmes:** Buddhist Studies, Dogri, English, Hindi, Punjabi, Sanskrit, Urdu, Arabic, Kashmiri (Kishtwar Campus only), Journalism & Media Studies, Commerce (M.Com), Education (M.A), Education (M.Ed), Physical Education (B.P.Ed), Physical Education (M.P.Ed), LL.B Professional (3 Years), Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Environment Sciences, Botany, Zoology, Sericulture (Poonch Campus only), Human Genetics, MCA (Computer Science & IT), M.Sc -IT (Kishtwar Campus only), Statistics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Geography, Home Science, Applied Geology, Remote Sensing & GIS, Physics, Electronics, History, Economics, Library Sciences (B.Lib.I.Sc), Library Sciences (M.Lib.I.Sc), Rural Development, Political Science, Sociology, Psychology & Philosophy.
 - b) **Post Graduate (PG) Diploma Programmes:** PG Diploma in Business Management (PGDBM), PG Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA) (Kishtwar Campus only), PG Diploma in Human Rights & Duties Education, PG Diploma in Bioinformatics, PG Diploma in Composite Culture Management, PG Diploma in Yoga & PG Diploma in Museology.
 - c) **Four Year Under Graduate Programmes (FYUP under NEP-2020):** B.Com. Bhaderwah & Udhampur Campuses, B A (English) Kathua Campus Only.
 - d) **Under Graduate Programmes:** Law (B.A.LLB - 5 years), BBA (Hotel Management).
3. There shall be two sets of question papers, one for PG/ PG Diploma and the other for FYUP/ UG programmes comprising 150 objective type questions of one mark each. The level of questions shall be of 12th standard in case of candidates appearing for UG Programmes and Graduation for the candidates appearing for PG Programmes. Level of numerical ability shall be of 10th standard for both the Question Papers. Time duration for the entrance test shall be 2 ½ hours.
4. The contents of the paper and weightage shall be:

a. General English	40 questions	c. Reasoning	40 questions
b. Gen. Knowledge	40 questions	d. Numerical Ability	30 questions
5. Weightage of Academic Merit of the qualifying examination is **75%** and Entrance Test is **25%**.

NOTE: For every wrong answer there shall be negative marking of 0.25 marks.
