Candidates desirous to appear for admission to LL.M. (2 years) Programme, 2026-27 are advised to bring the following documents and fill up the Choice Form available in the office of Department of Law strictly according to the schedule;

1. Hard copy of online application Form
2. CUET Score card
3. All Mark lists 10th to LL.B.

4. Provisional Certificate/Copy of Degree certificate
5. Latest Character certificate
6. Mark lists of PG if the candidate has already done Master in any discipline
7. Category certificate of candidate seeking admission under any reserved category
8. Domicile certificate
9. Affidavit sworn before the judicial Magistrate for the appearing candidates that he/she will produce the final result within 45 days
10. Affidavit sworn before the Judicial Magistrate declaring that the candidate shall not join any practice in any court/tribunal as advocate during this period and shall maintain 75% attendance in the department.
11. General affidavit

Note: The candidates who have already applied online for admission to LL.M. (2 years) programme shall only be eligible to appear in the offline counselling. Candidates whose name have already figured during first two rounds of admission shall not be considered for off line counselling. All candidates have to produce the required documents at the time of counselling. No relaxation whatsoever (except migration certificate) shall be given and candidate fails to produce require documents shall forfeit his/her right.
