This initiative is aimed at fostering high-impact, in particular, international collaborations in research, teaching and innovation.

Established in 1969, the University of Jammu is a premier public institution located in **Jammu (UT of Jammu & Kashmir), India**. The **main campus of the University at Jammu** offers a vibrant academic environment supported by modern infrastructure, laboratories, library resources and well established research centers. In addition to its main campus, the University has seven **off-site campuses** at Baderwah, Kathua, Reasi, Poonch, Ramnagar, Udhampur and Kishtwar, thereby enabling the University to enhance its academic reach and regional engagement. These campuses contribute to region-specific research, particularly in areas such as mountain ecology, rural development, socio-economic studies, sustainability and the like.

Accredited with NAAC A⁺⁺ and ranked among India's leading public universities, the University of Jammu is steadily strengthening its global research footprint with the University's faculty and scholars contributing actively to internationally indexed research, with increasing visibility in global academic platforms.

The University comprises 50+ teaching departments under various Faculty, including Faculty of Sciences, Faculty of Life Sciences, Faculty of Mathematical Sciences, Faculty of Social Sciences, Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Business Studies, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Engineering and Faculty of Medical Sciences. The doctoral programme (Ph.D) is offered in these Faculty in 40+ departments/disciplines. These departments, which are well equipped infrastructurally also host Post Doctoral Fellows, Research Assistants and the

Visiting Faculty for research engagement. The Research and Development (R&D) cell established under the aegis of office of Dean Research Studies aims to strengthen the University's research ecosystem in line with the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020), by fostering a supportive research environment, encouraging collaborations with industry and institutions, and ensuring effective utilisation of resources and funding for enhanced research productivity.
