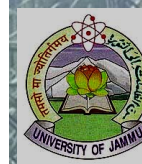

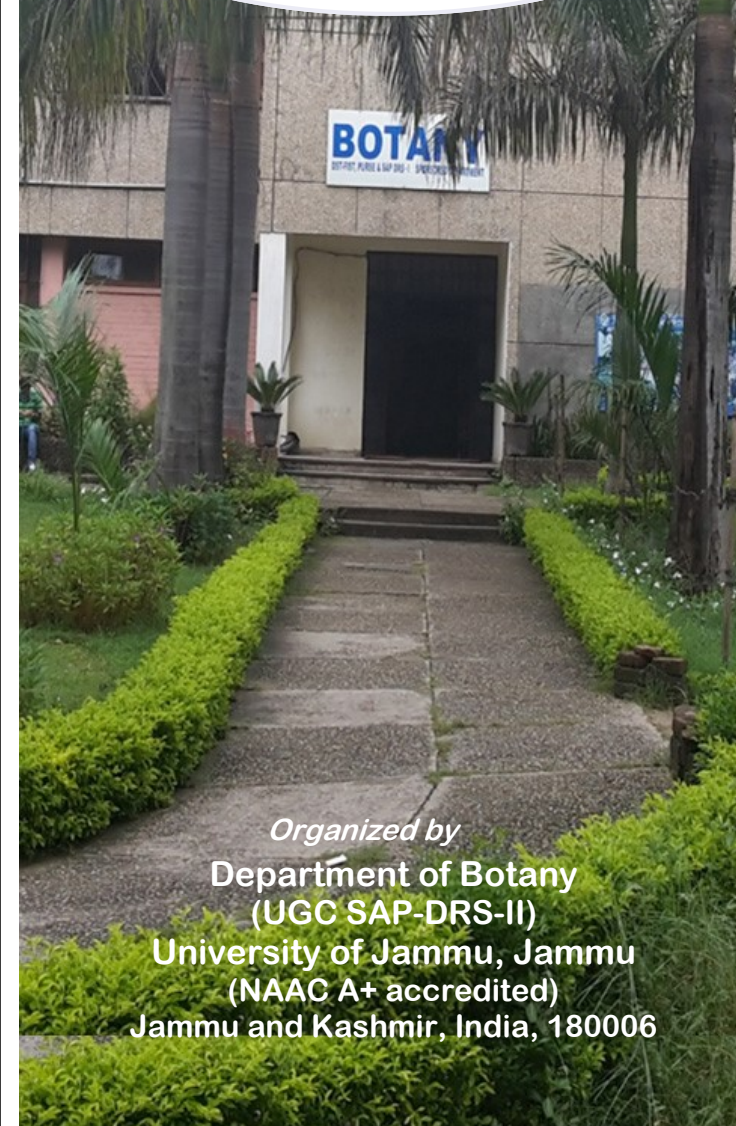

Department of Botany, University of Jammu is an important centre of learning in plant sciences offering post graduate courses and avenues of research in plant sciences. In a short span of 24 years of its independent existence, the department has excelled in various research areas like mycology, mushroom science, plant pathology, ecology, cytology, cytogenetics, molecular biology, plant stress physiology, biosystematics, reproductive biology, ethnobotany, and conservation biology with the help of generous financial support from UGC-SAP DRS-I & II, DST (FIST), CSIR, GBPIHED, MoEFCC, DST, DBT, FAO, NMHS, JKSTIC and other funding agencies. Over the period of time, alumni of the department have carved out niches for themselves at national and international levels in fields of teaching, research and administration.

Infrastructural facilities

The Department has well equipped Central Instrumentation Labs., seminar hall, internet facility, departmental library, teaching labs., herbarium, museum and a BGCI recognized botanical garden. Spread over an area of 6.2 acres the Botanical Garden houses more than 2000 plants distributed into 850 species in addition to glass and greenhouses with a portion dedicated to herbals and mushroom culture. Department has AAS, HPLC, RTPCR, UV-VIS spectrophotometers, high speed refrigerated centrifuges, incubator-shakers, stereo and compound microscopes with camera attachments, fluorescence microscope, Gel-doc, rota-evaporator, -20°C & -80°C deep freezers and other equipments for research.
