After a 60-minute lunch break, practical sessions on climbing and route selection ensued.

Days 4-5: 3rd February and 4th February 2024

Practical classes on rappelling, river crossing, hazards during hiking, and trekking were conducted by Mr. Pranav Bandral, Mr. Rashid Aslam, Mr. Manik Bandral, and Mr. Neeraj Rakwal at Bajalta and River Tawi. A 30-minute break preceded a class on jumaring, followed by a 60-minute lunch break and practical on river crossing.

Day 6: 5th February 2024

Mr. Neeraj Rakwal taught about mountaineering equipment, while Mr. Manik Bandral covered high altitude sickness and its prevention. Mr. Rashid Aslam discussed mountain manners, and Mr. Manik Bandralconducted a session on desert trekking.
