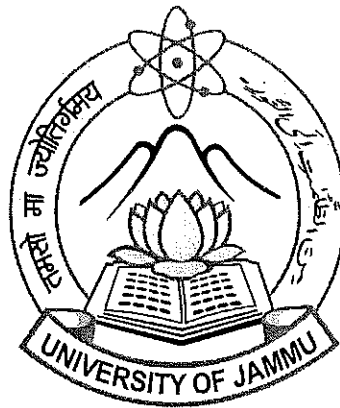

At the outset, the Hon'ble Chancellor (Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Jammu & Kashmir) welcomed all the members of the University Council present in the meeting. Vice Chancellor, University of Jammu introduced the new members namely Shri Ram Niwas Sharma, IAS, Commissioner Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department, Prof. Suman Jamwal, Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences, University of Jammu and Prof. Ravinder Singh, President, Jammu University Teachers Association (JUTA) before the Council.






The Hon'ble Chancellor also placed on record his appreciation and thanked the outgoing members of the Council namely Shri Shantmanu, IAS, Financial Commissioner (Additional Chief Secretary), Higher Education Department, Shri Shahid Iqbal Choudhary, IAS, Administrative Secretary, Planning & Development Department, Prof. Sangeeta Gupta, Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences and Dr. Vijay Saigal, President, Jammu University Teachers Association, for their significant contribution to the University during their tenure as members of the University Council.

In his introductory remarks, the Hon'ble Chancellor congratulated Prof. Alok Kumar Rai, (Council Member) on his appointment as the Director of the Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Kolkata. He also urged him to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the University of Jammu to facilitate academic outreach and collaboration between the two premier institutions.

The Hon'ble Chancellor appreciated the University's continuous efforts towards fostering academic excellence, promoting innovative research and development and ensuring the holistic development of students. He acknowledged the institution's proactive approach in adopting modern teaching methodologies, enhancing research culture and encouraging interdisciplinary learning. He also commended the University for its initiatives in strengthening student-centric programs, skill development activities and promoting overall personality development through co-curricular and extra-curricular engagements. He emphasized that such sustained efforts will not only enhance the quality of education but also prepare students to meet the evolving challenges of the modern world with competence and confidence.

Directions and Emphasis of the Hon'ble Chancellor (Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, J&K)


- The Hon'ble Chancellor emphasized that the University must establish clear benchmarks for innovation and research, with regular revision of academic curricula to integrate Artificial Intelligence (AI) and other cutting-edge Information Technology (IT) advancements.
- The University of Jammu was directed to collaborate with financial institutions to enhance student employability and to undertake a rigorous impact assessment of the existing skill development courses.
- The Chancellor stressed the need for dedicated measures to promote studies in local cultural heritage, languages and arts along with the revival of the Guru Nanak Dev Chair.
- To address local challenges particularly in disaster management the University was instructed to develop advanced early warning systems for natural disasters through its Department of Geology.
- For ensuring administrative efficiency, the Hon'ble Chancellor directed for early implementation of complete e-office system, IT-enabled services and biometric attendance system to ensure punctuality among both teaching and non-teaching staff and also to place a mechanism to ensure strict monitoring of the same in the University.
- The Chancellor called for increased participation of youth in the *Yuva Connect Programme* and their active engagement in the *Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyan*, along



with other national awareness initiatives and sharing of the progress reports with the office of Chancellor on monthly basis.

- University was directed to expedite the process of direct recruitment for various posts, ensure effective implementation of a robust and comprehensive Sports Policy and enhance the overall quality of teaching, learning and research at the University.
- Special emphasis was laid on the time-bound completion of infrastructure projects with strict adherence to quality standards. The University authorities were instructed to take necessary steps for the early completion of pending projects at the Bhardwah Campus and other Offsite Campuses.
- The Chancellor reiterated that the meetings of the University Council should be held twice a year.
- Further, the Hon'ble Chancellor directed the Principal Secretary to the Government, Finance Department (Financial Advisor, Universities) and the Commissioner Secretary to the Government, Higher Education Department, J&K to initiate the process for creation and sanction of teaching and non-teaching posts for the off-site campuses of the University in a phased manner with reference to the proposal already submitted to the Higher Education Department.
- To promote the cultural diversity of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, the Chancellor emphasized that all Universities in the U.T. should jointly organize Inter-University Cultural events/competitions.
- Both the University of Jammu and University of Kashmir were directed to adopt the admission policy framed by the SKUAST, Kashmir in respect of foreign students.
- University of Jammu should revisit the proposal in consultation with the Higher Education Department with respect to introduction of B.Sc. Nursing at Poonch Campus of the University of Jammu keeping in view the fact that the same course is also being run by the Baba Ghulam Shah Badshah University, Rajouri.
- University shall adopt and replicate the best practices initiated by other Universities in J&K such as Baba Ghulam Shah Badshah University has commissioned a solar power plant with a capacity of 01 MW which shall help in the generation of green and clean energy reducing dependence on the conventional sources of energy.
